GOD SAID SO!

What did God say?

101 THINGS GOD SAID Old Testament

God said...

- 1) He is the Lord that healeth me (Ex. 15:26).
- 2) My days shall be one hundred and twenty years (Gen. 6:3).
- 3) I shall be buried in a good old age (Gen. 15:15).
- 4) I shall come to my grave in a full age like as a shock of corn cometh in his season (Job 5:26).
- 5) When He sees the blood, He will pass over me and the plague shall not be upon me to destroy me (Ex. 12:13).
- 6) He will take sickness away from the midst of me and the number of my days He will fulfill (Ex. 23: 25, 26).

- 7) He will not put (allow) any of the diseases I am afraid of on me, but He will take all sickness away from me (Deut. 7:15).
- 8) It will be well with me and my days shall be multiplied and prolonged as the days of heaven upon the earth (Deut. 11:9,21).
- 9) He turned the curse into a blessing unto me, because He loved me (Deut. 23:5 and Neh. 13:2).
- 10) He has redeemed me from every sickness and every plague (Deut. 28:61 and Gal. 3:13).
- 11) As my days, so shall my strength be (Deut. 33:25).
- 12) He has found a ransom for me, my flesh shall be fresher than a child's and I shall return to the days of my youth (Job 33:24, 25).
- 13) He has healed me and brought up my soul from the grave; He has kept me alive from going down into the pit (Ps. 30:1, 2).
- 14) He will give me strength and bless me with peace (Ps. 29:11).
- 15) He will preserve me and keep me alive (Ps. 41:2).
- 16) He will strengthen me upon the bed of languishing; He will turn all my bed in my sickness (Ps. 41:3).
- 17) He is the health of my countenance and my God (Ps. 43: 5).
- 18) No plague shall come near my dwelling (Ps. 91:10).
- 19) He will satisfy me with long life (Ps. 91:16).
- 20) He heals all my diseases (Ps. 103:3).
- 21) He sent His word and healed me and delivered me from my destructions (Ps. 107:20).
- 22) I shall not die, but live, and declare His works (Ps. 118:17).
- 23) He heals my broken heart and binds up my wounds (Ps. 147:3).
- 24) The years of my life shall be many (Pr. 4:10).
- 25) Trusting Him brings health to my navel and marrow to my bones (Pr. 3:8).
- 26) His words are life to me, and health/medicine to all my flesh (Pr. 4:22).
- 27) His good report makes my bones fat (Pr. 15:30).
- 28) His pleasant words are sweet to my soul and health to my bones (Pr. 16:24).
- 29) His joy is my strength. A merry heart does good like a medicine (Neh. 8:10; Pr. 17:22).
- 30) The eyes of the blind shall be opened. The eyes of them that see shall not be dim (Isa. 32:3; 35:5). (My eyes are not dim, and they see perfectly, without restriction, both spiritually and physically).
- 31) The ears of the deaf shall be unstopped. The ears of them that hear shall hearken (Isa. 32:3; 35:5). (My ears do harken for I have ears that hear perfectly, without restriction, both spiritually and physically).
- 32) The tongue of the dumb shall sing. The tongue of the stammerers shall be ready to speak plainly (Isa. 35:6; 32:4). (My tongue is ready to speak plainly, clearly, and without restriction, both spiritually and physically).

- 33) The lame man shall leap as a hart (Isa. 35:6).
- 34) He will recover me and make me to live. He is ready to save me (Isa. 38:16, 20).
- 35) He gives power to the faint. He increases strength to them that have no might (Isa. 40:29).
- 36) He will renew my strength. He will strengthen and help me (Isa. 40:31; 41:10).
- 37) To my old age and gray hairs He will carry me and He will deliver me (Isa. 46:4).
- 38) Jesus bore my sickness (Isa. 53:4).
- 39) Jesus carried my pains (Isa. 53:4).
- 40) Jesus was put to sickness for me (Isa. 53:10).
- 41) With Jesus' stripes I am healed (Isa. 53:5).
- 42) He will heal me (Isa. 57:19).
- 43) My light shall break forth as the morning and my health shall spring forth speedily (Isa. 58:8).
- 44) He will restore health unto me, and He will heal me of my wounds (Jer. 30:17).
- 45) Behold He will bring it (me) health and cure, and He will cure me, and will reveal unto me the abundance of peace and truth (Jer. 33:6).
- 46) He will bind up that which was broken and will strengthen that which was sick (Eze. 34:16).
- 47) Behold, He will cause breath to enter into me and I shall live. And He shall put His Spirit in me and I shall live (Eze. 37:5,14).
- 48) Whithersoever the rivers shall come shall live. They shall be healed and every thing shall live where the river comes (Eze. 47:9).
- 49) Seek Him and I shall live (Amos 5:4, 6).
- 50) The Sun of righteousness has arisen with healing in his wings (beams) (Mal. 4:2).

New Testament

God said...

- 51) He (Jesus) will, be thou clean (Mt. 8:3).
- 52) Jesus took my infirmities (Mt. 8:17).
- 53) Jesus bore my sicknesses (Mt. 8:17).
- 54) If I be sick I need a physician. (He is the Lord my physician) (Mt. 9:12 & Ex. 15:26).
- 55) He is moved with compassion toward the sick and He heals them (Mt. 14:14).
- 56) He heals all manner of sickness and all manner of disease (Mt. 4:23).
- 57) According to my faith, be it unto me (Mt. 9:29).

- 58) He gives me power and authority over all unclean spirits to cast them out, and to heal all manner of sickness and all manner of disease (Mt. 10:1 & Lk. 9:1).
- 59) He heals them all (Mt. 12:15 & Heb. 13:8).
- 60) As many as touch Him (Jesus) are made perfectly whole (Mt. 14:36).
- 61) Healing is the children's bread (Mt. 15:26).
- 62) He does all things well. He makes the deaf to hear and the dumb to speak (Mk. 7:37).
- 63) If I can believe, all things are possible to me cause I believeth (Mk. 9:23; 11:23, 24).
- 64) When hands are laid on me, I shall recover (Mk. 16:18).
- 65) His anointing heals the brokenhearted, and delivers the captives, recovers sight to the blind, and sets at liberty those that are bruised (Lk. 4:18; Isa. 10:27; 61:1).
- 66) He heals all those who have need of healing (Lk. 9:11).
- 67) Jesus is not come to destroy men's lives but to save them (Lk. 9:56).
- 68) Behold, He gives me authority over all the enemy's power and nothing shall by any means hurt me (Lk. 10:19).
- 69) Sickness is satanic bondage and I am loosed today (Lk. 13:16 & II Cor. 6:2).
- 70) In Jesus is life (Jn. 1:4).
- 71) Jesus is the bread of life. He gives me life (Jn. 6:33, 35).
- 72) The words Jesus speaks unto me are spirit and life (Jn. 6:63).
- 73) Jesus is come that I might have life, and that I might have it more abundantly (Jn. 10:10).
- 74) Jesus is the resurrection and the life (Jn. 11:25).
- 75) If I ask anything in Jesus' name, He will do it (Jn. 14:14).
- 76) Faith in Jesus' name makes me strong and gives me perfect soundness (Acts 3:16).
- 77) He stretches forth His hand to heal (Acts 4:30).
- 78) He, Jesus Christ, makes me whole (Acts 9:34).
- 79) Jesus does good and heals all that are oppressed of the devil (Acts 10:38).
- 80) His power causes diseases to depart from me (Acts 19:12).
- 81) The law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death (Rom. 8:2).
- 82) The same Spirit that raised Jesus from the dead now lives in me and that Spirit will quicken my mortal body (Rom. 8:11).
- 83) My body is a member of Him (Jesus) (I Cor. 6:15).
- 84) My body is the temple of the Holy Spirit and I am to glorify Him in my body (I Cor. 6:19, 20).
- 85) If I'll rightly discern Jesus' body which was broken for me, and judge myself, I will not be judged and I will not be weak, sickly or die prematurely (I Cor. 11:29-31).

- 86) He has set gifts of healing by the Spirit in the body (Church) (I Cor. 12:9).
- 87) Jesus' life may be made manifest in my mortal flesh (II Cor. 4:10, 11).
- 88) He has delivered me from death, He does deliver me, and if I trust Him, He will yet deliver me (II Cor. 1:10).
- 89) He has given me Jesus' name and has put all things under my feet (Eph. 1:21, 22).
- 90) He wants it to be well with me and He wants me to live long on the earth. (Eph. 6:3).
- 91) He has delivered me from the authority of darkness (Col. 1:13).
- 92) He will deliver me from every evil work (II Tim. 4:18).
- 93) Jesus tasted death for me. He destroyed the devil who had the power of death. He's delivered me from the fear of death and bondage (Heb. 2:9, 14, 15).
- 94) He washes my body with pure water (Heb. 10:22; Eph. 5:26).
- 95) Lift up the weak hands and the feeble knees. Don't let that which is lame be turned aside but rather let Him heal it (Heb. 12:12, 13).
- 96) Let the elders anoint me and pray for me in Jesus' name and He will raise me up (Jas. 5:14, 15).
- 97) Pray for one another and he will heal you (Jas. 5:16).
- 98) By Jesus' stripes I was healed (I Pet. 2:24).
- 99) His divine power has given unto me all things that pertain unto life and godliness through the knowledge of Him (II Pet. 1:3).
- 100) Whosoever will let him come and take of the water of life freely (Rev. 22:17).
- 101) Beloved, I wish above all things that you may...be in health (III Jn. 2).
