## Be Psalm 91 Equipped

Q: Psalm 91 equipped?? What does THAT mean? A: It means to <u>confess</u> Ps.91 <u>each</u> day and <u>SPEAK</u> the promises of God, so that you can receive all of the blessings that are in there!

Why speak?

Say this instead!

<u>Psalm 91: NKJ</u> <sup>1</sup>He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High Shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.

- <sup>2</sup>I will say of the LORD, "He is my refuge and my fortress; My God, in Him I will trust."
- <sup>3</sup> Surely He shall deliver you from the snare of the fowler *And* from the perilous pestilence.
- <sup>4</sup>He shall cover you with His feathers, And under His wings you shall take refuge; His truth *shall be your* shield and buckler.
- <sup>5</sup> You shall not be afraid of the terror by night, *Nor* of the arrow *that* flies by day,
- <sup>6</sup> Nor of the pestilence that walks in darkness, Nor of the destruction that lays waste at noonday.
- <sup>7</sup> A thousand may fall at your side, And ten thousand at your right hand; *But* it shall not come near you.
- <sup>8</sup> Only with your eyes shall you look, And see the reward of the wicked.
- <sup>9</sup> Because you have made the LORD, who is my refuge, Even the Most High, your dwelling place,
- <sup>10</sup> No evil shall befall you, Nor shall any plague come near your dwelling;
- <sup>11</sup> For He shall give His angels charge over you, To keep you in all your ways.
- <sup>12</sup> In *their* hands they shall bear you up, Lest you dash your foot against a stone.
- <sup>13</sup> You shall tread upon the lion and the cobra, The young lion and the serpent you shall trample underfoot.
- <sup>14</sup> "Because he has set his love upon Me, therefore I will deliver him; I will set him on high, because he has known My name.
- <sup>15</sup> He shall call upon Me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him and honor him.
- <sup>16</sup> With long life I will satisfy him, and show him My salvation."

I declare that I will dwell in the shelter of the Most High God, and will find rest in the shadow of the Almighty.

I declare that God is my refuge and fortress; you are my God, in whom I trust and with great confidence, in whom I will rely.

I declare that God will rescue me from every trap and protect me from every disease.

I declare that I am covered and protected by His outstretched arms.

I declare that God's faithful promises are my armor and my protection.

I declare that I will not be afraid of the terrors of night, nor of the arrows that fly in the day.

I declare that I will not dread any disease that stalks in the darkness, nor any disaster that strikes at midday.

I declare that because God is my refuge and the Almighty God of my home, no evil can befall me, and no plague can come near my dwelling.

I declare that God has ordered His angels to guard, defend, and protect me and my house.

I declare that God's armies of heaven will keep me from falling. I will walk unharmed and kick anything that is evil from my path.

I declare that because of God's love for me that I will call upon him, and He will set me above all my troubles, He will deliver me from all my fears, and will honor me with His presence and power.

I declare that He will reward me with long life, and He will show me his salvation.

I am now Psalm 91 equipped, in Jesus' mighty name, Amen.

Q: Why is <u>SPEAKING</u> so important?

A: Because the things that you say, actually matter! Whatever you speak, regardless if it is good or bad, WILL come to pass. So we need to always choose, speak, pray, and confess words that are inline with God's Word and will.

And most importantly, whenever you pray or confess the Word, you must <u>BELIEVE</u> that you will <u>RECEIVE</u> the blessings that you've prayed and confessed for!!!

Here's why.....

PROV 18:21 NKJ <sup>21</sup> **Death** and **life** are <u>in the power of</u> the tongue, and those who love it will eat its fruit.

This one is clear.....what you say, matters!

Watch what you say! What you say can be harmful and you'll have to answer for it. MATT 12:36 ESV <sup>36</sup> I tell you, on the day of judgment **people will give account for every careless** word they speak,

MATT 15:11 NLT <sup>11</sup> It's not what goes into your mouth that defiles you; you are defiled by the words that come out of your mouth."

REV 12:11NKJ <sup>11</sup> And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the **word of their testimony**, and they did not love their lives to the death.

him = devil blood of the Lamb = Jesus testimony = CONFESSIONS! \* You beat the devil with your confessions (speak!) \*

DEUT 30:19 NKJ <sup>19</sup> I call heaven and earth as witnesses today against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing; therefore choose life, that both you and your descendants may live;

MARK 11:23-24NKJ <sup>23</sup> For assuredly, I say to you, whoever <u>says</u> to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and <u>does not doubt in his heart,</u> <u>but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says</u>. <sup>24</sup> Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, <u>believe that you receive them, and you will</u> have them.

God tells us to <u>choose</u> Life, so <u>choose to speak</u> words of Life.

Important! They may not come immediately, but believe that they WILL come!
